## Titan Class Science

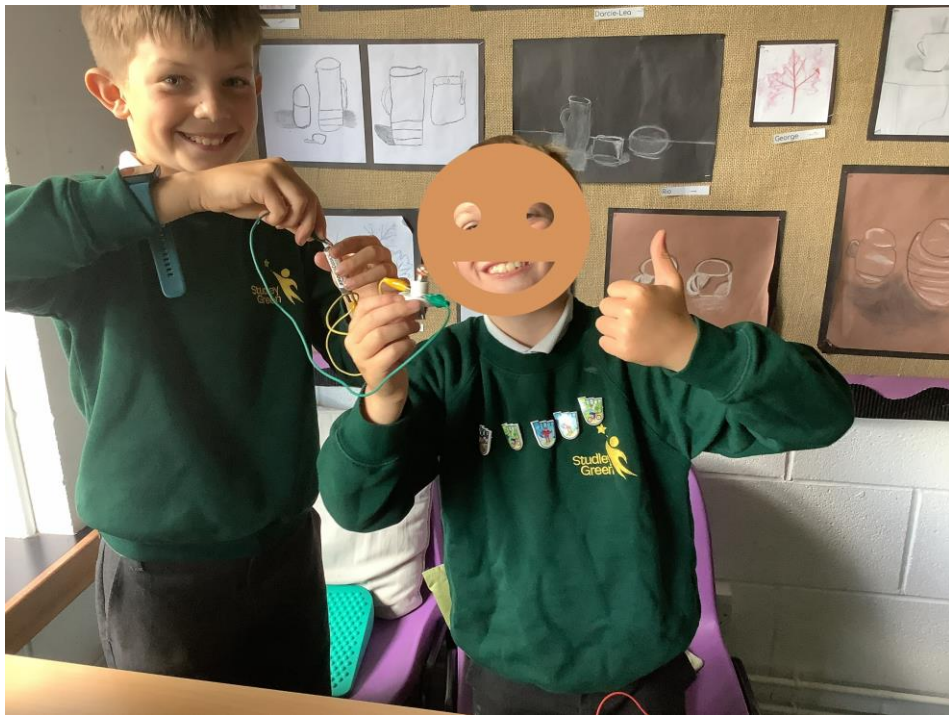


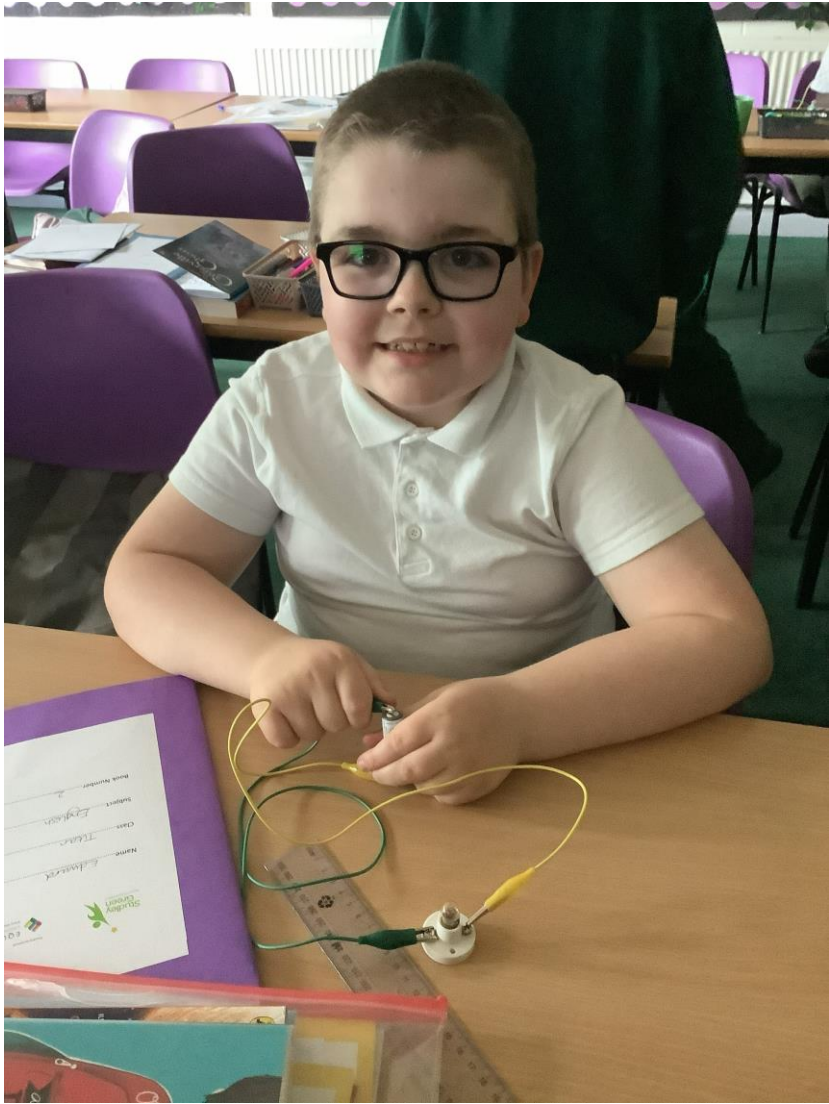
In Science this week, Titan Class had fun learning about electricity.

The castles look amazing!







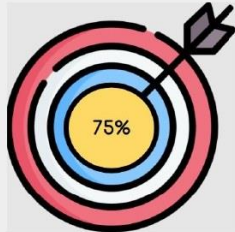


Did you know ...?

My Favourite Picture Book by Mrs Pemberton



'The Lion Who Wanted to Love' is a warm, funny and thoughtful picture book written by Giles Andreae. It tells the story of a lion who doesn't want to roar, fight or scare others — he just wants to be kind and loving.

The story teaches us a really important lesson: You don't have to be fierce or loud to be strong.

The lion learns that being gentle, caring and true to yourself is something to be proud of. Even when others expect him to behave like a "typical" lion, he shows that kindness can change minds and hearts. This makes the book perfect for talking about feelings, friendship and being yourself.

One of the best things about this book is the rhyming text. The rhymes are smooth, fun and easy to follow, which makes the story great to read aloud. The rhythm helps the story flow and the words sound musical and playful.

I love the illustrations because they are bright, expressive and full of personality. The lion's facial expressions clearly show his emotions, so you can understand how he's feeling even without the words. The pictures work perfectly with the story, adding humour and warmth.

It is my go-to book for reading to children of all ages (I have read this many times to my own boys!!) because it reminds us that love and kindness are powerful, and that being yourself is the best thing you can be.
