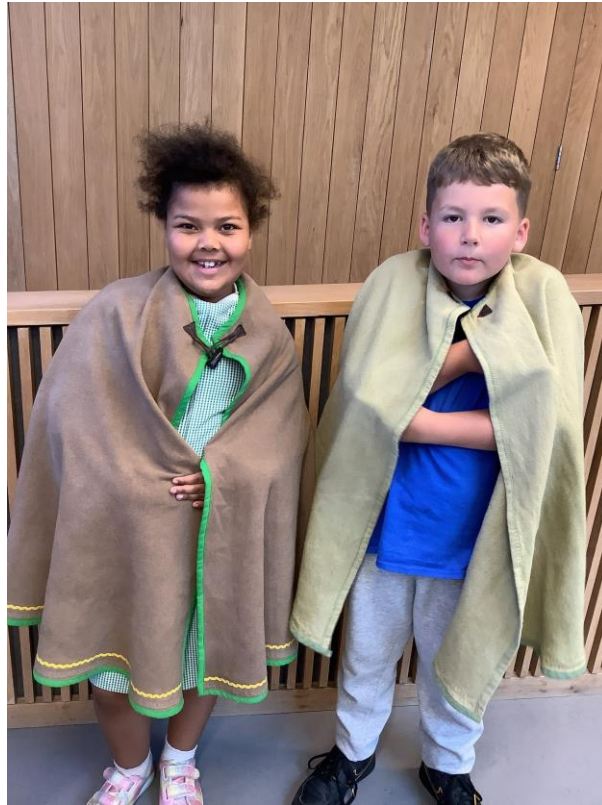














Pan Class Trip to Warleigh Lodge Farm

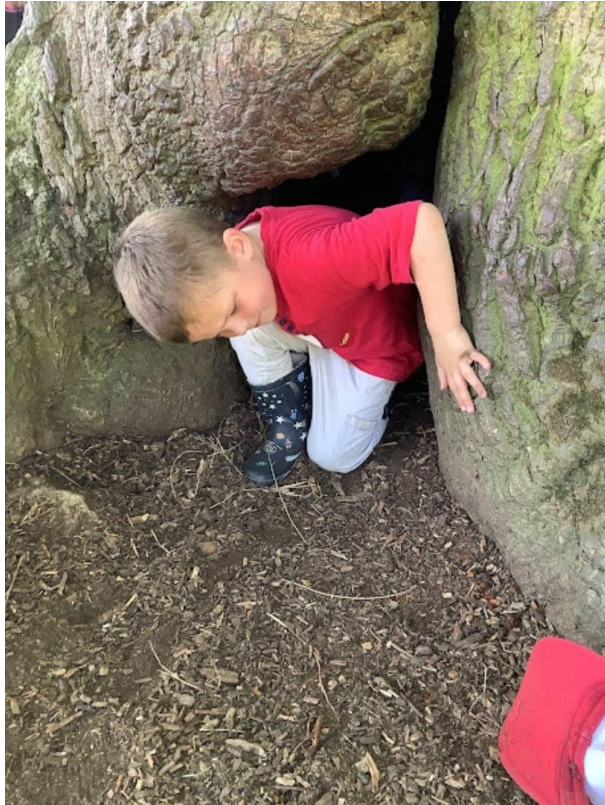


Pan class had a wonderful time at the farm on Wednesday. A day full of joy!

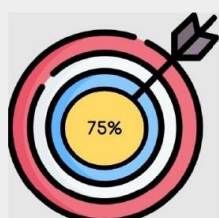

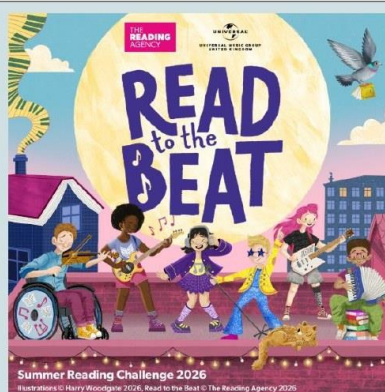
